

High-Efficiency Commercial Washer Rebate Program



Purchase a High Efficiency Commercial Washer and receive a \$220 rebate

The Contra Costa Water District is offering a \$220 rebate (per machine) for the purchase or lease (5-year) of new High Efficiency Commercial Washer(s) that have a Water Factor of 7.5 or less, from the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE) www.cee1.org approved list of washers.

Rebate Guidelines

- Only High-Efficiency Commercial Washers from the CEE approved list of commercial washers qualify for rebate. The purchased washer model number must be on the CEE List of Commercial Clothes Washer qualifying products on the day of purchase. Please visit www.cee1.org for a list of approved washers.
- New commercial washer(s) must have a water factor of 7.5 or less, and be installed in multifamily common laundry or coin operated commercial laundries to be eligible for the rebate
- Approved washers(s) must be purchased on or after January 1, 2009. Applications will be processed until funds are depleted and are subject to the availability of funds.
- Purchase and install CEE approved High-Efficiency Washer(s) before submitting rebate application.
- Rebate Application must be postmarked within 60 days of purchase date.
- Applicant's Water Bill Account Number must be provided on application. Applicant name must be the same as water account customer of record.
- Approved washer(s) must be installed within the Contra Costa Water District Service Area: Antioch, Bay Point, Clayton, Clyde, Concord, Martinez, Oakley, Pacheco, Pittsburg, Pleasant Hill (parts), Port Costa, and Walnut Creek (parts).
- Original dated sales receipt for new washer(s) must be submitted with application.
- Incomplete applications and those without an original dated receipt will be denied.
- The CCWD rebate of \$220 applies only to the Purchase/Lease of new washer(s).
- All participants are subject to a washer inspection prior to receiving a rebate.
- Please allow up to 8 weeks for rebate to be processed.

**** High-Efficiency Washers (HEWs) use 30%-50% less water than standard top loading (agitator) washers .**
