1 to 15 Lots..... \$10,000
 16 to 25 Lots..... \$15,000
 26 Lots or More..... TBD
 Service Agreements..... \$6,000
 (Services, Fire Hydrants & Fire Services)

PROJECT CONSTRUCTION DEPOSIT

Prior to construction documentation preparation, Applicant shall deposit with the District the District's estimated project costs (Code of Regulations 5.28.060).

NEW FEES - IMPLEMENTATION

Implementation of all fees associated with new connections to the District's treated water system shall be incorporated using Code of Regulations 5.08.030-040 as follows:

- 1) Submit a completed "Application for Service" as specified in the attached Requirements for Treated Water Service. (Note: Multi-phase subdivision projects must include approved improvement plans. See Section 5.08.030 of the District's Code of Regulations for additional information and details).
- 2) Submit an applicable deposit as specified herein.
- 3) Effective January 1, 2011, all new residential construction will require a residential fire sprinkler system, per the 2010 California Building Code.
