\$175 HET REBATE for *WaterSense*[®] Toilets!

Contra Costa Water District (CCWD) is offering a rebate of up to \$175 in material costs (tank/bowl) for the purchase of a new WaterSense[®] labeled High-Efficiency Toilet (HET). Below are eligibility requirements:

Eligibility:

1. Existing toilet(s) replaced must be older than 1994 (3.5 gallons/flush or more)
2. New toilet(s) must be WaterSense[®] labeled and purchased on or after July 1, 2010
3. Participants must agree to have a post-inspection by CCWD staff before receiving the rebate
4. Toilets must be installed in the Contra Costa Water District service area, which includes: Antioch, Bay Point, Clayton, Clyde, Concord, Oakley, Pittsburg, Port Costa, and parts of Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill, Martinez, and Brentwood

How to Participate:

1. Call CCWD to verify eligibility and to request an HET rebate application,* Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Applications can also be requested on our website at any time.
2. Purchase and install your new HET.
3. Fill out and submit to CCWD your rebate application with original sales receipt for the new HET.
