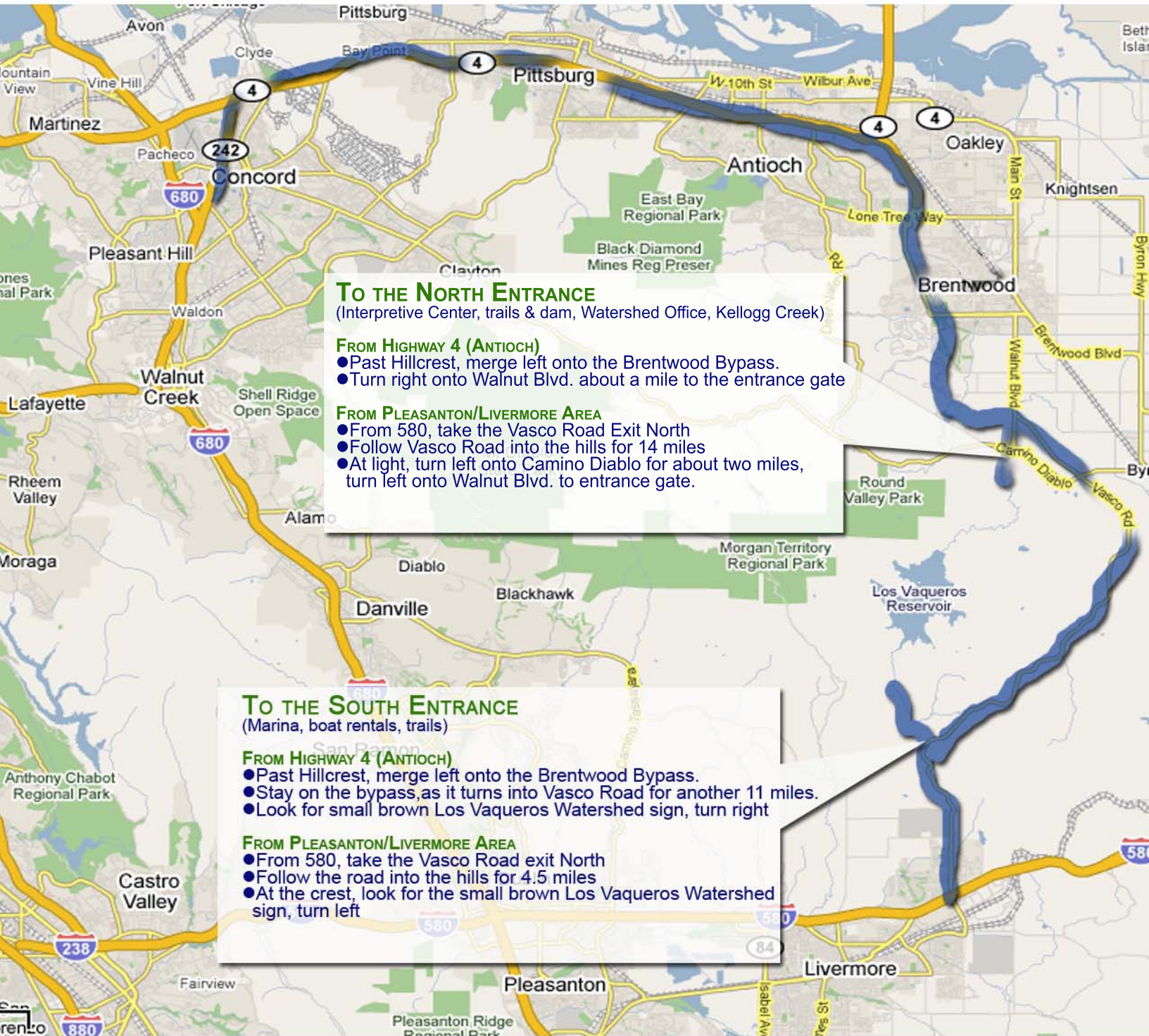


# Getting to Los Vaqueros with the new bypass



## TO THE NORTH ENTRANCE

(Interpretive Center, trails & dam, Watershed Office, Kellogg Creek)

### FROM HIGHWAY 4 (ANTIOCH)

- Past Hillcrest, merge left onto the Brentwood Bypass.
- Turn right onto Walnut Blvd. about a mile to the entrance gate

### FROM PLEASANTON/LIVERMORE AREA

- From 580, take the Vasco Road Exit North
- Follow Vasco Road into the hills for 14 miles
- At light, turn left onto Camino Diablo for about two miles, turn left onto Walnut Blvd. to entrance gate.

## TO THE SOUTH ENTRANCE

(Marina, boat rentals, trails)

### FROM HIGHWAY 4 (ANTIOCH)

- Past Hillcrest, merge left onto the Brentwood Bypass.
- Stay on the bypass, as it turns into Vasco Road for another 11 miles.
- Look for small brown Los Vaqueros Watershed sign, turn right

### FROM PLEASANTON/LIVERMORE AREA

- From 580, take the Vasco Road exit North
- Follow the road into the hills for 4.5 miles
- At the crest, look for the small brown Los Vaqueros Watershed sign, turn left
