As of January 1, 2011 all new residential construction will require fire sprinklers to be installed per the 2010 California Residential Code. Per the California Department of Health Services (Code 17, Sections 7588 and 7594) a backflow prevention device will also be required. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that, as specified in sections 5.08.070.C and 5.16.050.D of the District's Code of Regulations, the District may terminate service at any time for non-compliance with any regulation of the District or default in any payment due to the District and understands that termination of service will also terminate any fire suppression system connected to the terminated service. Applicant further acknowledges and agrees that, in the event of such termination for non-compliance with any regulation of the District or default in any payment due to the District, the District shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or inconvenience to any person or property by reason of any interruption, suspension, or termination of water service and/or fire service. Applicant further acknowledges the provisions of section 5.04.060 of the District's Code of Regulations, which provide in part that the District shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or inconvenience to any person by reason of any shortage, reduction, interruption, or discontinuance of water service or the increase or decrease of water pressure, when the same is caused by an act of God, drought, an unavoidable accident, a shutdown, a disturbance or condition of any kind beyond the reasonable control of the District, or when the same is reasonably necessary for the repair, maintenance, alteration, or extension of any facility of the District or of the Contra Costa Canal System of the United States Bureau of Reclamation.

The undersigned Applicant requests Contra Costa Water District (“District”) to supply water at the premises noted hereon and agrees to pay the District for all water so supplied in accordance with current District schedule of rates, which shall from time to time be legally modified as approved by the District Board of Directors, to provide land rights in a form satisfactory to the District, to abide by regulations of “modified pressure service areas” per District Code of Regulations 5.08.010 and 5.08.020 (if required and as approved by the Board of Directors), and to abide by all current District rules and regulations as approved by the District Board of Directors. Applicant shall be charged all applicable fees and costs, including service connection fees (Section 5.08.040 of District’s Code of Regulations), in effect on the official date of application. **FRC payment is acknowledgement by the Applicant that they have reviewed any and all relevant information related to existing services and their applicability towards this project and are satisfied that the meter sizes and number requested are necessary. Once paid, the FRC will “run with the land” and will not be refundable.**

The Applicant has requested water service from the District. In order to receive this water service, the Applicant requests that the District place a service lateral and water meter in the immediate vicinity of the premises noted hereon the attached map. Every effort will be made by the District to locate the service lateral, water meter box, and backflow device within the public right-of-way in the vicinity as defined by the Applicant. If the Applicant determines that the service lateral, water meter box, and backflow device are located outside the public right-of-way, the District shall relocate the service lateral, water meter box, and backflow device inside the public right-of-way or the Applicant shall provide to the District an easement for the necessary land rights to properly locate District facilities.
