Marina Building & Boat Docks Closed For Construction Activities Starting Monday, Oct. 10 *Shoreline Fishing & Parking Continue to be Available*

The Contra Costa Water District is enlarging the Los Vaqueros Reservoir by 60 percent to hold 160,000 acre-feet of water. This will ensure water quality and supply reliability for the 500,000 people served by the reservoir. The project includes moving the Los Vaqueros Marina and other recreational facilities to higher ground. To ensure public safety, the entire north side of the watershed and portions of the watershed's south side are already closed to the public.

Starting Monday, October 10, the Los Vaqueros Marina, the boat docks, and another section of the shoreline on the south side of the watershed will be closed to the public. As a result, there will be no boating at Los Vaqueros for several months. These closures are necessary so that recreational facilities can be moved to higher ground to accommodate the expanded reservoir. All facilities on the north and south sides are expected to reopen in Spring 2012.

Limited shoreline fishing will continue to be available along the south shore and about 20 parking spaces will continue to be available in the Marina parking lot. Also, trails that are not in the closure areas, including the Miwok Trail that connects Round Valley Regional Park to Morgan Territory Regional Preserve, will remain open to the public. The District apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause.

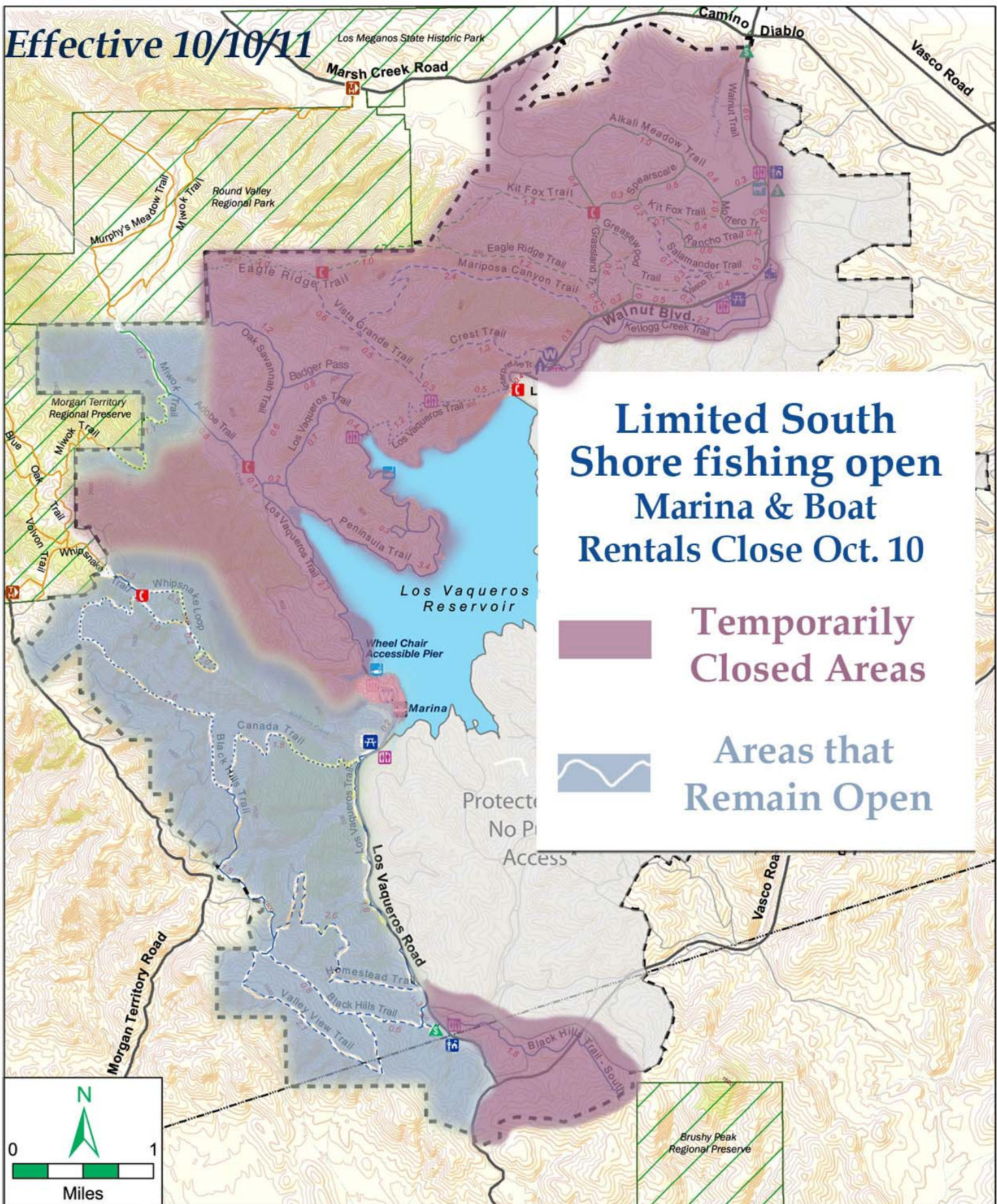
