Los Vaqueros Watershed Closed November 21 - December 10 For Necessary Construction Activity

The Contra Costa Water District is enlarging the Los Vaqueros Reservoir by 60 percent to hold 160,000 acre-feet of water. This will ensure water quality and supply reliability for the 500,000 people served by the reservoir. The project includes moving the Los Vaqueros Marina and other recreational facilities to higher ground.

To ensure public safety, the south side of the watershed will be temporarily closed starting November 21. Reopening of the south side of the watershed is expected to occur on December 10, depending on construction progress and weather conditions. An earlier reopening date may be possible. The north side of the watershed has been closed since March and will remain closed until Spring 2012. The Miwok Trail that connects Round Valley Regional Park to Morgan Territory Regional Preserve has remained open throughout the reservoir expansion project and will continue to be open while the rest of the watershed is closed.
