Temporary Conservation Pricing Considered

To encourage all customers to conserve water, the Contra Costa Water District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing June 3, 2015, to consider temporary conservation pricing, a fine for violating prohibitions and adjusting the baseline usage to 2013, as called for in Gov. Jerry Brown's executive order. If approved, customers would see the following changes:

- **Temporary conservation pricing:** A temporary price adjustment of 50 cents per 748 gallons would take effect for households that use 200 or more gallons of treated water per day.
- **Fine:** Customers violating water-use prohibitions would first receive a warning. Subsequent violations could result in a fine of up to \$500, a penalty of \$10 per 748 gallons wasted and suspension of service. A complete list of prohibitions is available at www.ccwater.com.
- **Baseline usage:** As mandated by the state, reductions in water use would be measured against your 2013 water use. Please see the reverse side of this card for ways to find out your 2013 use.
