Pipeline Replacements Boost Reliability



There is what seems like an endless number of water pipes hidden beneath our streets. They vary in size, function, and age. To maintain a well-running system and to avoid expensive emergency repairs, Contra Costa Water District staff monitor nearly 900 miles of pipe to determine when replacement is more cost-effective than repair. A portion of your payments for water service are reinvested in system upgrades like pipe replacement. Many pipes scheduled for replacement are old, have a history of leaks, or present other problems. This proactive approach is why clean, safe water is available at your tap more than 99.99% of the time. It also keeps costs low and without surprises.
