Water Service Lines to be Relocated

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Due to increased material procurement lead times and the District taking extra precautions and proceeding more slowly than originally planned, we now expect Phase 1 of the Grove Way Water Service Line Relocation Project to be completed by late-February. Crews are working as safely and as efficiently as possible to complete this project. We apologize for any inconvenience caused by this delay.

Most water service lines will be relocated by the end of this week. Remaining work includes the installation of new valves, abandonment of the 6" water pipeline, and restoration of trenches and any disturbed landscaping.

Work Schedule

Phase 1: Expected to be completed by late-February
Phase 2: Spring 2022
Work hours: 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday
(Night/weekend work is not planned but may become necessary to keep on schedule.)

Grove Way Service Line Relocation Project

Contra Costa Water District is relocating water service lines connected to a 6" water pipeline beneath Grove Way between Clayton Road and Cowell Road. The water service lines will be replaced with new copper pipes and will be transferred to a parallel 12" water pipeline also beneath Grove Way. Work will be completed in two phases. Following each phase of work, a section of the 6" pipeline will be isolated from the system and no longer in service. This work will improve the reliability of water service in your neighborhood. Please see the other side of this notice for a list of services to be relocated.

What to Expect

Crews will create an open trench to relocate water service lines beneath the street. As work progresses on Grove Way, traffic patterns may shift, and parking restrictions may become necessary. At the end of each shift, trenches will be covered, and the site will be cleaned. The trench area will be repaved at the end of the project. While work is underway, you should expect an increase in construction-related traffic and noise. When the project is complete, the trench and any disturbed landscaping will be restored to pre-construction conditions.

Temporary Water Outage

A temporary water outage is necessary to complete this work. If your home will be affected by a temporary outage, you will receive a notice via door hanger approximately 48-hours in advance of the planned outage.

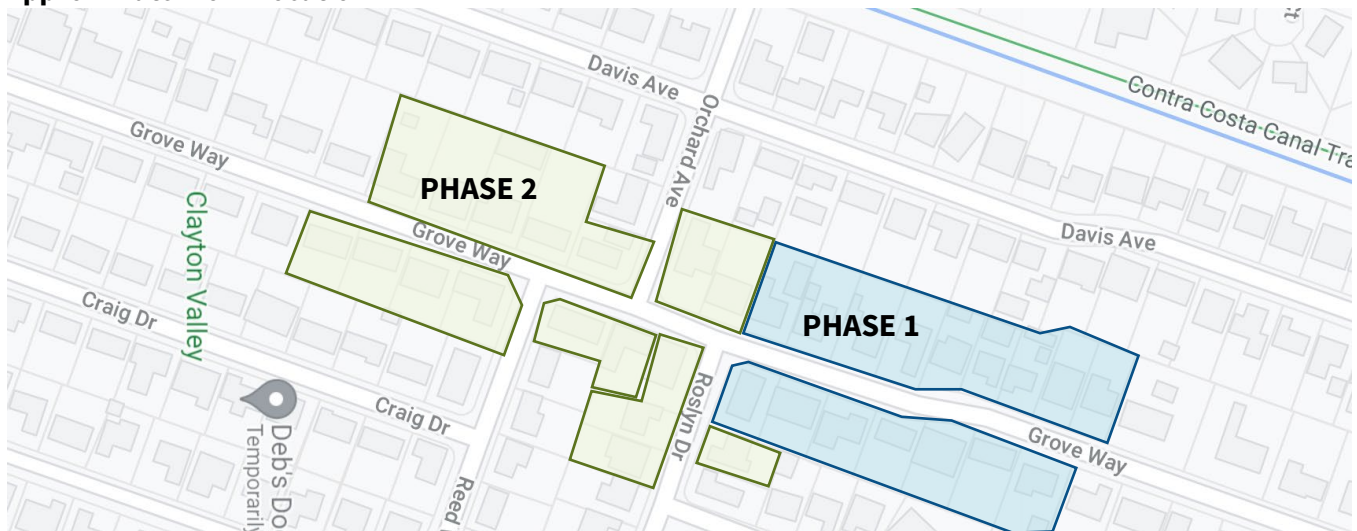
Water flushing

To complete construction, District crews must flush water from the system. This flushing ensures integrity of the new pipes as well as safe, clean water to your tap. We use best management practices to ensure activities are safe for the environment and only flush as much water as is required. Water will be diverted directly into a nearby storm drain. Unfortunately, it is not possible to capture this water for other purposes. Drainage path will be identified and evaluated prior to flushing and physical barriers like sandbags will be placed where necessary to prevent water flowing into private property.
