Neighborhood Water Pipes to be Upgraded

Contra Costa Water District will soon construct new water pipes in your neighborhood to improve the reliability of your water service. This project will replace approximately 950 feet of aging water pipes that have a history of costly and disruptive leaks. A project map is on the opposite side of this notice. A portion of your payments for water service are used for high-quality and long-lasting system upgrades, like pipeline replacements, which avoid future costly breaks and service interruptions to the pipes that deliver water to your home.

Work Schedule

Work to begin: As soon as March 7, 2022

Estimated end: June 2022

Work hours: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday

Weekend work is not planned but may become necessary to keep the project on schedule.

What to Expect

Crews will create an open trench to install the new water pipes beneath the street. As work progresses, traffic patterns may shift, and parking restrictions will become necessary. At the end of each shift, trenches will be covered, and the work area will be cleaned. While work is underway, you should expect an increase in construction-related traffic and noise. If an open trench is blocking access to your street or driveway, please alert crews and allow several minutes for a steel plate to be placed over the trench. When the project is complete, disturbed landscaping will be restored to pre-construction conditions and the trench will be repaved. Contra Costa Water District has coordinated this project with the City of Walnut Creek.

Temporary Water Outage

Temporary water outages lasting less than one day at a time are necessary to complete this project. If your home will be subject to a planned water outage, you will receive a separate notice in advance of the outage.

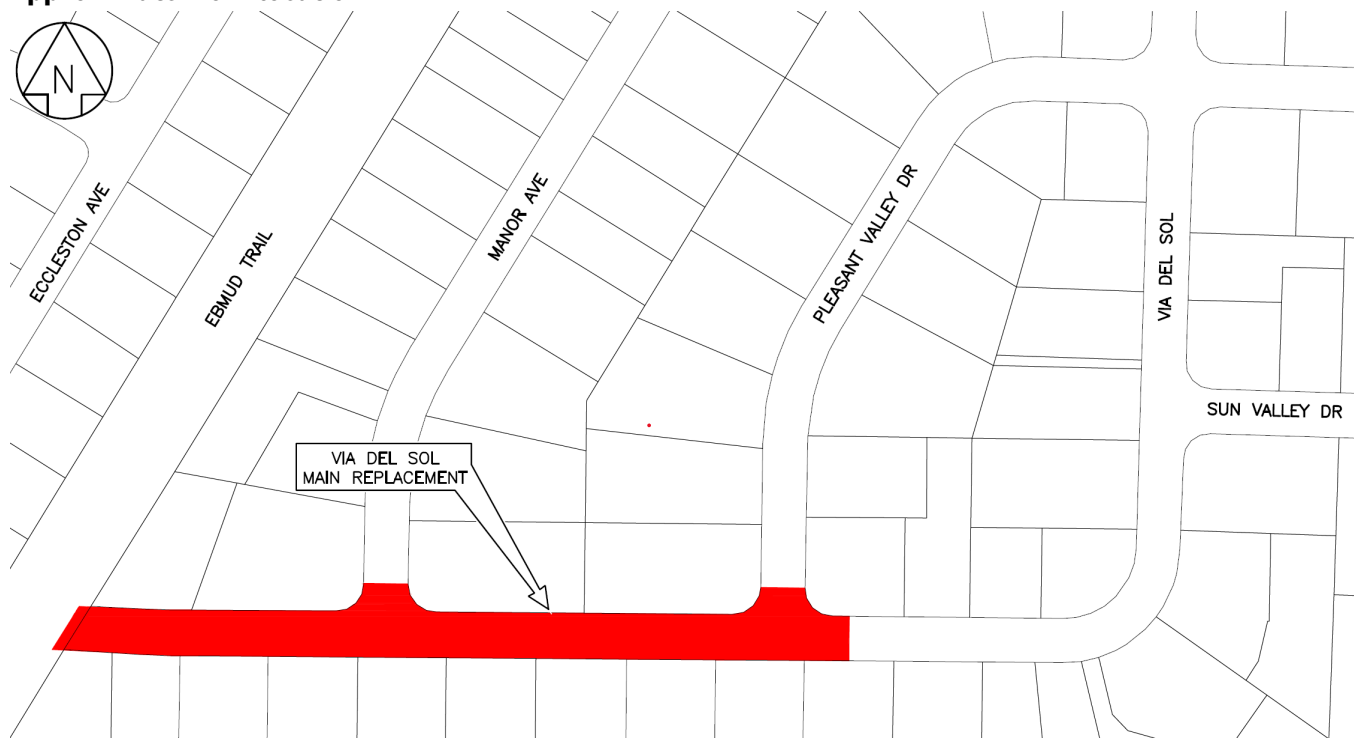

Water flushing

During construction, you may notice water running down the street. To complete construction, District crews must flush water from the system. This flushing ensures integrity of the new pipes as well as safe, clean water to your tap. We use best management practices to ensure activities are safe for the environment and only flush as much water as is required. Unfortunately, it is not possible to capture this water for other purposes.
