Retaining Wall to be Rebuilt to Improve Hydrant Access

Contra Costa Water District will soon construct a new retaining wall near the fire hydrant shown on the opposite side of this notice. This project will improve accessibility to the hydrant for Fire Department personnel, as well as District employees. A portion of your payments for water service is used for high-quality and long-lasting system upgrades, which keep our system in good working order.

Work Schedule

Work to begin: As soon as Thursday, April 4, 2022

Time to complete: Three weeks

Work hours: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday

Weekend work is not planned, but may be necessary to keep the project on schedule.

What to Expect

Crews will construct a new retaining wall to replace the existing retaining wall that is failing and obstructing access to the fire hydrant. To construct the new retaining wall, crews must stage heavy equipment in the roadway. During construction, the road may be partially or completely blocked; however, the contractor will re-open the road to provide access for vehicles as needed. Please allow up to a 15-minute delay for crews to move equipment and allow passage. To minimize traffic impacts, the roadway will remain unobstructed before 8 a.m. and after 4 p.m. each day.

While work is underway, you should expect an increase in construction-related traffic and noise. The site will be cleaned at the end of each day. Your water service will not be affected by this project. Contra Costa Water District is coordinating this project with Contra Costa County and the Crockett Carquinez Fire Department.
