	For design assistance, use our Landscape Design Assistance Program.
	For drip irrigation assistance, use our Drip Irrigation Design Coupon.
	Remove your lawn.
	Remove all sprinkler heads from the project area. No sprinklers may remain in the project area.
	If you are removing only part of the lawn, the sprinkler system must be revised to ensure that the remaining lawn is irrigated on a separate valve/ station from the new landscape. In addition, sprinklers on adjacent lawn areas may not spray onto the new landscape.
	Select your plants from CCWD's Approved Plant List.
	Verify that 50% of the project area will be covered by the plants when they are mature.
	Hardscape must be permeable to water to be included.
	Drip systems must use a pressure regulator and filter to ensure they function properly.
	Install a minimum of two inches (2") of mulch in planting areas.
	If you will be receiving a combined rebate of \$600 or more, complete
	and return the W-9 form to CCWD.
